**Old Business:**

**1. Employee Health:**

- Limited at-home COVID tests available for STAFF ONLY (provided by LG Health/Penn Medicine). Due to limited supply these are only to be given to staff who request them and are known close contacts or are concerned about possible symptoms they are experiencing. Tests are self-administered and it is *not* required to report these results to Solanco.
- Update to ModernEyes incentive. We now earn a free student eye exam/glasses for every *two* Solanco staff (and staff family member) exams/glasses purchases. This was previously only earned with glasses purchases. This program has provided glasses for 28 Solanco students since we began to partner with them and fills the gap for families who don't qualify for income-based programs but still need help obtaining vision care. Currently providing \$50 gift certificate to all Solanco staff members to add to normal employee discount for glasses and exams through 03/31/2022.

**2. COVID Updates:**

- DOH and LGH guidance have been updated to align with the CDC's 5-day quarantine and isolation recommendations.
- Solanco's health and safety plan is still worded to allow for parent choice regarding masking.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**1. Report of Food Services:**

**2. LG Health Updates:**

- Continuing to host local COVID vaccine clinics (Robert Fulton and Quarryville Library). Information available for interested families.
- Continuing with ChildProtect vaccine clinics for routine childhood immunizations (DTaP, polio, hepatitis B, MMR, varicella, TDaP, and meningococcal). Set up at Bart Fire Hall every other month with extra clinic in July to help with back-to-school demand.

**3. Employee Fitness Challenge:**

- Spring session of Solanco Strides to kick-off in March.
- Could use additional committee members and ideas for incentives. Two upcoming planning meetings.

**4. Behavioral Health Updates:**

- Current behavioral team members – Contracted a board certified behavior analyst (BCBA) through IU-13 and a BCBC through CCIU for our early learner program (Pre-K and kindergarten)
- “CPI Verbal De-Escalation” and “Check and Connect” training provided to staff members
- “Executive Functioning and Reinforcement” training provided to elementary paras
- School board looking at possibility of implementing therapy dogs within our schools
