Classroom Guidance lessons

The 6th grade learners will complete lessons November thru December and the focus will be on understanding self as it relates to careers.

7th grade will start receiving guidance March thru April. They will continue career exploration and start developing a career plan.

8th grade lessons will start lessons in November and run through the end of February. The focus is on high school course selection and creating a 4-year HS plan.

Additional Guidance Services Available to ALL students:

Students will be utilizing the SMARTFUTURES career readiness online program, which will follow them through High School.



6th Grade Team News



Language Arts- In Language Arts, students will begin the Informational Non-Fiction Unit and will use what they learned as the basis for the Informational/Explanatory Writing Unit.

LEAD- We are working on research for our Inventions project. Students will complete all of the research in LEAD class (including note taking, citations, and completing a bibliography). Students will then complete an informative writing in Language Arts class.

Math- In November students will be studying a unit on Ratios, Proportions, and Percentages. Topics covered will include ratios, rates, and percent problems involving discount and sales tax.

Science- In Science, sixth graders will be learning about different types of matter and the physical and chemical properties and changes used to identify one type of matter from another.

Social Studies- In social studies, students will learn about the ancient Indian culture.

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7th Grade Team News

Language Arts- In November, we will continuing to work on our Informational Nonfiction Unit with The Great Fire. This will lead into our Informational Writing Unit featuring Shipwreck at the Bottom of the World.

LEAD - In November, we will focus on "Before" and "During" reading strategies, and then connect them to a text-dependent analysis (TDA).

Math/Extensions - We will be starting our first algebra unit on solving one-step equations. This will be followed up with an application of one-step equations in which the students will be writing and solving proportions.

Science - Swift Scientist will finish learning about various types of chemical reactions and how the bonds in the reactants are broken to form new products. The 7th grade scientists will learn about the macromolecules structure and function that make up all living things in the middle of November.

Social Studies - We are exploring First People of the Americas and their migration into North and South America. Learners will also be tasked with knowing numerous basic geographic locations of North America such as the Atlantic Ocean, Mississippi River, Hudson Bay, Appalachian Mountains, etc. These locations will be key for the learners to know and understand as we move forward with the seventh grade social studies curriculum.



8th Grade Team News

Language Arts- In November, we'll continue our Holocaust units first by publishing our Spotlight articles and then by getting to know Anne Frank.



LEAD - In November, in LEAD, we will be practicing our non-fiction reading skills with a series of short articles. We will also be combining forces with ELA, to work on a research-based project at the end of the month!

ADV Algebra - We begin with an exploration of inequalities and proceed to advanced equation solving.

PRE Algebra - We are exploring the solving of equations and graphing equations this month.

Science – The SSI will be controlling the reaction of currently unknown substances by regulating temperature, concentration, surface area and the use of catalysts. The Public Enemy has been active and we are hot on their heels. We are going to be developing to scale gas propelled cars using the products from a chemical reaction. MORE TO COME.

Social Studies- For Social Studies class, students will be wrapping up their American Revolution unit! Students will have another exciting extra credit opportunity with creating an object for a Liberty Tree. In the second half of November, we are going to be starting the Early 1800s unit, which includes Washington as President, War of 1812, as well as Lewis and Clark's exploration.
