Outdoor Recess: It's getting colder out there! Please follow these guidelines for recess. Also it is important to stress that learners wear warm clothing. Please communicate with families that whenever possible we will be taking learners outdoors. Below are the guidelines to follow for staying indoors when it is cold out.

- Wind-Chill Factor: when the wind-chill factor is below 15 degrees Fahrenheit, indoor recess should be conducted for all students. When the wind-chill factor is between 15-30 degrees Fahrenheit, outdoor recess should be shortened and indoor recess should be conducted for a portion of the recess time.
