	Attendance
	Every student. Every day.
	Every studem. Every day.
•	A student may have up to 10 days absences a school year. (Doctor's excuse notes and p approved Educational Trips do not count toward the 10 total days for the year). If a studen absent more than 10 days, a doctor's note will be required for ALL absences after that.
•	Please remember to turn in an excuse note if your child has been absent. If an excuse note not handed in within three days of their return to school, it will be marked as an illegal absent. The school is required to consider three illegal absences as a summary offense for whe parents/guardians or persons in parental relation will be prosecuted through the courts .
•	If you drop off your child(ren) in the morning, please have them to school by 9:00am . The k rings at 9:00am and classroom instruction starts promptly at 9:15am. The teachers need time take attendance, lunch count, have the students unpack their backpacks, and get themselv settled. If your child is late arriving at school after 9:15am, a parent or guardian must w them in the lobby to sign them in or the tardy will be marked illegal.
•	A student arriving late before 11:00am will be marked tardy. A student arriving after 11:00 will be marked absent for $\frac{1}{2}$ day. A student leaving before 2:00pm, will be marked absent for $\frac{1}{2}$ day.
•	If your child has an appointment during school hours <u>, for the time missed to be excused, a doctor's note must be turned in.</u>
•	If you will be picking your child up early from school, please send in a note or email to ye <u>child's teacher and Mrs. Erb</u> . This way the teacher can have any missed work ready for ye child to take home. It is also helpful for the office to know that someone will be picking up ye child ahead of time.
•	When placing your child on pick-up for the end of the day, please send a note or email to y o child's teacher, or call/email Mrs. Erb no later than 3:00pm the day of.
•	Educational Trip forms must be submitted five days prior to the trip to be approved. In or for the trip to be legally excused, it must be educational in nature. Prior attendance records a previous requests will also be considered. Forms are available on-line at <u>www.solancosd.</u> They are also available in the office.

Chara	cter Counts - February			
In February we will be focusing on HC	ONESTY- what it means and how we be honest with others!			
To focus on honesty, teachers will read Doug-Dennis and the Flyaway Fib by Darren Farrell (K-2) or A Day's Work by Eve Bunting (3-5). Both books focus on various aspects of honesty. Teachers will follow these stories with discussion questions and activities to ensure students fully understand the concept of honesty and ways to demonstrate it. To extend this concept at home, help your child learn the difference between the truth and a lie with this simple game. You and your child take turns saying statements and the other person has to decide if it is a truth or a lie. A great game to play in the car or while you are waiting somewhere! Talk about honesty with your child by using the following discussion points: Has anyone ever been dishonest with you before? How did you feel? What do you think honesty means and why is it important? Tell me about a time when it was hard to be honest. What makes it hard to be honest? How will others view you if you are honest? How will others view you if you are dishonest?
