
We look forward to seeing everyone again in the new year!

Also, remind your children to wash their hands frequently and use hand sanitizer. This is the best way to prevent colds and the flu this season.


If your child has been sick, please remember that they will need to be <u>fever and symptom free for 24 hours</u> before returning to school.



SNOW DELAY INFORMATION FOR KINDERGARTEN

If we have a two-hour delay due to snow, the <u>AM Kindergarteners</u> will come to school at 1:00am and leave school at 1:00pm. **AM Kindergartners are**encouraged to bring a snack or light lunch to eat at school. Extended day

<u>Kindergartener students</u> will eat lunch as they do every day. PM Kindergartners will arrive at school at 2:00pm and leave at the regular dismissal time.

The results on this modified schedule are for morning and afternoon kindergarten to share in the 2-hour delay.

Solanco delays and cancellations are also posted on the WGAL TV-8 website, www.wgal.com. Delays and cancellations are also communicated via the Solanco School District app, the Solanco Facebook page, and via Solanco Twitter - @SolancoSchlDist - Follow Solanco on Twitter.

As a backup, the district will place an automated phone call to parents notifying them of 2-hour delays or school cancellations. The phone call is a secondary source of notification - parents should stay tuned to the local media listed above to learn if school is delayed or cancelled.

Bart-Colerain School Counseling

Character Counts - December

For December, we will be focusing on EMPATHY- what it means and how we can show empathy to others!

To focus on empathy, teachers will read The Buddy Bench by B.D. Cottleston (K-2) or Each Kindness by Jacqueline Woodson (3-5). Both books focus on various aspects of empathy. Teachers will follow these stories with discussion questions and activities to ensure students fully understand the concept of empathy and ways to demonstrate it. To extend this concept at home, help your child practice considering the needs of others. When you are watching tv or reading books, ask your child what he/she thinks the characters are feeling, and what they might need in that situation. What could you say or do to help that person?

Talk about empathy with your child by using the following discussion points: What does it mean to be empathetic and why is it important? Is it easy or difficult for you to have empathy for others? Tell me about a time when you were empathetic towards someone else. Tell me about a time when someone else was empathetic towards you. What would the world be like if people considered the feelings of others more often? How can you tell how someone else may be feeling? How can you tell what someone else may need?

Character Counts Breakfast

Each month, classroom teachers nominate a student in their class who exemplifies that monthly character trait. The nominees will be celebrated at a bi-monthly 'Pancakes with the Principal' breakfast. If your child brings home an invitation, please make sure to rsvp via the QR code. On December 13th we will celebrate our November and December nominees!!

Classroom Lessons- December

The following are the lessons/topics we will be covering in December:

1st Grade - In 1st grade, we will be talking about bullying-learning how to determine whether a situation is bullying or not bullying.

2nd Grade - In 2nd grade, the focus will be learning how to be an upstander- someone who sees something and says/does something about it.

3rd Grade- 3rd grade will review a definition of bullying and review scenarios to determine whether they are bullying/not bullying.

4th Grade- 4th graders will be practicing upstander skills using role play scenarios. 5th Grade- 5th graders will be discussing bullying to determine whether a situation is bullying/not bullying and practice recognizing, reporting, and refusing bullying.
