



Language Arts- This December, students will travel to the South Pole for our next nonfiction book, Shipwreck at the Bottom of the World.

Math/Extensions -We will be completing a unit on solving various problems involving percents.



Students will finish the month of December by learning about parts of a chemical reaction specifically synthesis and decomposition chemical reactions.

Social Studies - In the month of December, we are exploring ancient American civilizations. Learners will be creating Aztec calendars, trying to solve the Mayan disappearance mystery, and exploring the fabled Incan location of Machu Picchu.

LEAD - In Lead, we will be studying inferences by solving a few mysteries! We will also be working on our context clues to help define unfamiliar vocabulary words.

Advanced-Algebra - We will begin December by looking at advanced problem solving techniques calculating Domains and Ranges of functions. We will then begin exploring the area of geometry and its application to algebra.

Pre-Algebra - We will begin December by looking at graphing techniques for various equations and inequalities. We will then begin exploring the area of geometry and its application to algebra.
