### **2025/2026 Elementary Title 1 Survey:**

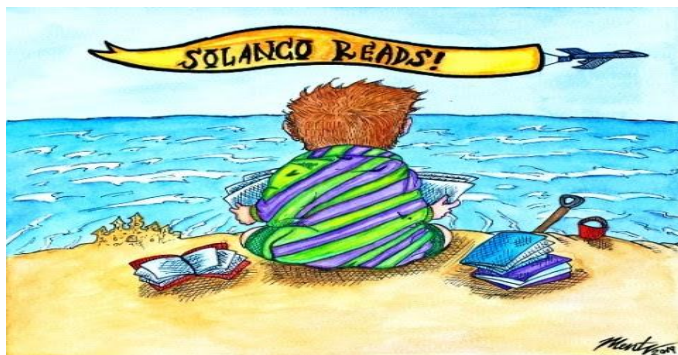
