Policy / Notice	Brief Description
All District Policies	Annual notice landing page directing families, students, staff, and the public to key school policies and required annual notices.
006 - Meetings	Explains how the Board provides public notice of meetings and conducts public business.
103 - Discrimination/Title IX Sexual Harassment Affecting Students	Prohibits discrimination, harassment, retaliation, and Title IX sexual harassment affecting students; identifies reporting and complaint procedures.
103.1 - Nondiscrimination - Qualified Students with Disabilities	Explains nondiscrimination protections and Section 504 rights for qualified students with disabilities.
104 - Discrimination/Title IX Sexual Harassment Affecting Staff	Prohibits discrimination, harassment, retaliation, and Title IX sexual harassment affecting employees and applicants.
105.1 - Review of Instructional Materials by Parents/Guardians and Students	Explains parent/guardian and student rights to inspect instructional materials used in the educational program.
105.2 - Exemption from Instruction	Describes procedures for requesting exemption from specific instruction when permitted by policy and law.
113 - Special Education	Provides notice of special education programs, evaluations, services, procedural safeguards, and Child Find responsibilities.
114 - Gifted Education	Describes gifted education identification, evaluation, services, and parent/guardian rights.
115 - Career and Technical Education	Provides information about access to career and technical education opportunities and nondiscrimination in CTE programs.
123 - Interscholastic Athletics	Describes eligibility, participation expectations, and requirements for students participating in interscholastic athletics.
123.1 - Concussion Management	Provides concussion and traumatic brain injury information, acknowledgement requirements, and return-to-play expectations.
123.2 - Sudden Cardiac Arrest	Provides sudden cardiac arrest warning signs, acknowledgement requirements, and return-to-play expectations.
138 - Language Instruction Educational Program for English Learners	Explains identification, placement, services, and parent/guardian notification for English Learners.
142 - Migrant Students	Describes supports and identification procedures for students who may qualify for migrant education services.
143 - Standards for Persistently Dangerous Schools	Explains unsafe school choice requirements if a school is identified as persistently dangerous.
144 - Standards for Victims of Violent Crimes	Explains rights and transfer options for students who are victims of violent criminal offenses at school.
200 - Enrollment of Students	Explains enrollment requirements and procedures for students entering the district.
201 - Admission of Students	Provides admission requirements and procedures, including documentation required at enrollment.
203 - Communicable Diseases and Immunization	Provides information on required immunizations, communicable disease rules, and school health exclusions when applicable.
204 - Attendance	Explains compulsory attendance, lawful and unlawful absences, truancy procedures, and school attendance improvement steps.
209 - Health Examinations/Screenings	Describes school health screenings and examinations required or provided during the school year.
209.1 - Health Program	Summarizes student health services and school health program requirements.

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209.2 - Diabetes Management	Explains planning and supports for students with diabetes, including individual health and care plans.
210 - Medications	Explains procedures for administering prescription and nonprescription medications during school hours.
210.1 - Possession/Administration of Asthma Inhalers/Epinephrine Auto-Injectors	Explains requirements for students to possess or self-administer asthma inhalers or other approved emergency medications.
216 - Student Records	Explains FERPA rights, student record access, directory information, disclosure rules, and parent/eligible student rights.
218 - Student Discipline	Describes expectations for student behavior, disciplinary responses, and due process protections.
218.1 - Weapons	Explains rules and consequences related to weapons on school property, at school events, and in school vehicles.
218.2 - Terroristic Threats/Acts	Describes procedures and consequences for terroristic threats or acts affecting school safety.
218.3 - Discipline of Student Convicted/Adjudicated of Sexual Assault	Explains procedures when the district is notified that a student has been convicted or adjudicated of sexual assault.
220 - Student Expression/Distribution and Posting of Materials	Explains student expression rights and rules for distributing or posting materials in school.
222 - Tobacco and Vaping Products - Students	Prohibits student possession or use of tobacco and vaping products as defined by policy and law.
226 - Searches	Explains when student lockers, belongings, vehicles, or persons may be searched under policy and law.
227 - Controlled Substances/Paraphernalia	Explains rules and consequences related to controlled substances, look-alike substances, and paraphernalia.
233 - Suspension and Expulsion	Describes suspension and expulsion procedures, timelines, hearings, and student due process rights.
235 - Student Rights/Surveys	Explains student rights, responsibilities, access to instructional materials, and annual survey/privacy notifications.
236.1 - Threat Assessment	Explains the district threat assessment process, team responsibilities, and reporting options for school safety concerns.
237 - Electronic Devices	Explains student use, possession, and restrictions related to personal electronic devices.
246 - School Wellness	Describes the district wellness policy, nutrition standards, physical activity, and public involvement in wellness review.
247 - Hazing	Prohibits hazing and explains reporting, investigation, and discipline related to school organizations and activities.
249 - Bullying/Cyberbullying	Prohibits bullying and cyberbullying and explains reporting, investigation, discipline, and support procedures.
250 - Student Recruitment	Explains disclosure of secondary student information to military recruiters and postsecondary institutions and related opt-out rights.
251 - Homeless Students	Explains McKinney-Vento rights, school stability, enrollment, transportation, and district liaison support for students experiencing homelessness.
252 - Dating Violence	Explains prevention, reporting, investigation, and response procedures for dating violence and related retaliation.
312 - Evaluation of Superintendent	Describes the annual superintendent evaluation process and related public statement requirements when applicable.
323 - Tobacco and Vaping Products - Employees	Prohibits employee use of tobacco and vaping products in school settings as defined by policy and law.
324 - Personnel Files	Explains maintenance and access to personnel files, including information relevant to qualifications and employment records.
604 - Budget Adoption	Explains budget development, public review, adoption, and notice requirements.
619 - District Audit	Explains annual audit requirements and public availability of audit information.
621 - Local Taxpayer Bill of Rights	Provides taxpayer rights and local tax appeal or complaint procedures.
705 - Safety	Describes district safety responsibilities and practices to maintain safe schools and facilities.
707 - Use of School Facilities	Explains public use of district facilities, application procedures, fees, insurance, and restrictions.

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716 - Integrated Pest Management	Provides notice of the district's integrated pest management program and pesticide application notification procedures.
806 - Child/Student Abuse	Explains mandated reporting duties and procedures for suspected child abuse or student abuse.
808 - Food Services	Provides information about meal programs, free/reduced-price meals, meal charges, nutrition, and food service operations.
810.2 - Transportation - Video/Audio Recording	Notifies families and students that school buses or school vehicles may be equipped with video and audio recording equipment.
815 - Acceptable Use of Internet, Computers and Network Resources	Explains acceptable use, student accounts, internet safety, filtering, privacy, and discipline for technology use.
815.1 - Use of Generative Artificial Intelligence in Education	Explains expectations for responsible use of generative AI tools when used in instruction or schoolwork, if adopted.
819 - Youth Suicide Awareness, Prevention and Response	Provides suicide prevention information, response procedures, training expectations, and support resources.
823 - Naloxone Administration in School	Explains district procedures for maintaining and administering naloxone in school settings.
824 - Maintaining Professional Adult/Student Boundaries	Explains expectations for appropriate professional boundaries between adults and students.
830 - Security of Computerized Personal Information/Breach Notification	Explains protections for computerized personal information and notification procedures if a reportable breach occurs.
904 - Public Attendance at School Events	Explains expectations for spectators and public attendance at school events.
906 - Public Complaint Procedures	Explains how parents/guardians, employees, residents, and the public may submit concerns or complaints.
918 - Title I Parent and Family Engagement	Explains parent and family engagement rights, annual meetings, school-parent compacts, and Title I communication.
