We are proud to honor Jessica Cabrera Billings, a member of the Solanco High School Class of 2019, whose accomplishments as a student-athlete, leader, scholar, and role model have earned her a lasting place among Solanco's finest.

As a four-year letter winner in girls' basketball, she became one of the most accomplished players in program history and helped establish a standard of excellence.

During her senior season in 2019, she was named the Section 3 Most Valuable Player, recognizing her as one of the premier players in the Lancaster-Lebanon League. She earned First Team All-Section honors in both 2018 and 2019, demonstrating a level of consistency and excellence that few athletes achieve. Her talents also earned statewide recognition when she was selected as a Second Team All-State player in 2019, placing her among Pennsylvania's elite high school basketball players.

Among her many accomplishments, Jessica joined one of the most exclusive groups in high school basketball by surpassing 1,000 career points. Reaching this milestone requires far more than talent alone. It demands years of dedication, countless hours of practice, and a relentless commitment to improvement. Her place among Solanco's 1,000-point scorers ensures that her name will forever be remembered in the history of the girls' basketball program.

Perhaps the defining moment of her athletic career came during her senior season when she helped lead the Golden Mules to the 2019 Section 3 Championship. As one of the team's leaders, Jessica played a vital role in guiding Solanco through a memorable championship run.

While attending Solanco Jessica embodied the very definition of a student-athlete. As a member of the National Honor Society, she demonstrated academic excellence while balancing the demands of athletics and extracurricular activities. Jessica was a member of the WSLC Media Team, helping share the stories and accomplishments of fellow students and athletes. She also served as President of the Varsity Club, one of the highest leadership roles available to student-athletes at Solanco.

Following her graduation from Solanco, Jessica attended West Chester University, where she majored in Health Science with a Pre-Medical Studies focus.

Demonstrating the same commitment and determination that defined her athletic career, she completed her degree in just three and a half years and graduated in 2022 as a Summa Cum Laude graduate.

While her achievements in athletics and academics are impressive, Jessica's greatest accomplishments may be found in the life she has built beyond school. She is a business owner as a wedding photographer, she is married to fellow Solanco graduate Anthony Billings, and together they have built a growing family.
